PUBLIC COMMENT

Kester Kornegay asked if any action came about as a result of last month's closed session; Mayor Holt said no action was taken last month, but the board would meet again tonight on the possibility of property acquisition and could possibly take action then.

Terry Rains asked again about the post office and the possibility of post offices being closed down, and he asked if Wilson's Mills could get a postal route, why couldn't Pine Level do the same. Mayor Holt said he would try and look into the matter. Commissioner Garner suggested contacting Congressman Bob Etheridge for some assistance. Mayor Holt agreed to draft a letter to send the congressman. Mr. Rains also suggested that property owners check their insurance policy, because he finally got his address listed as Pine Level and it was a lot cheaper than the Selma address formerly on his policy.
