RESOLUTION URGING RESIDENTS TO OBSERVE A SAFE HALLOWEEN

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Commissioners of the Town of Pine Level that residents who desire to participate in traditional Halloween Trick-or-Treating observe certain safety, courtesy and common sense guidelines to protect participants and preserve the peace for non-participants.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Board of Commissioners suggests the following guidelines:

- That Halloween Trick-or-Treating should take place on the actual Halloween holiday, Friday, October 31, 2025, and should be restricted to children under the age of 13.
- That all children taking part in Trick-or-Treating should be clothed in safe costumes, featuring materials that can be seen in the dark by motorists and masks that do not obstruct the children's vision.
- That all children taking part in Trick-or-Treating should be accompanied by a responsible older person who can protect
 the children from harm.
- That Trick or Treating is conducted during reasonable hours, preferably between 6:00 8:00 p.m.
- That those who choose not to participate in Halloween indicate so to others by leaving their porch lights off; and that participants respect the wishes of those who choose not to participate in Halloween by not visiting homes where porch lights are off.
- That children Trick-or-Treat in their own neighborhoods, visiting only familiar homes.
- That parents and/or guardians inspect collected treats carefully before children eat them.
- That suspicious activities or collected treats that show signs of tampering be reported immediately to the Pine Level Police Department.
- Those persons over the age of 12 wanting to participate in Halloween events by wearing a costume should not wear masks.
