**ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING WITHIN
SPECIFIED AREAS OF THE TOWN OF PINE LEVEL**

WHEREAS, pursuant to NCGS160A-301, "a town may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and prohibit the parking of vehicles on the public streets, alleys and bridges within the city;" and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Pine Level, North Carolina deems it to be in the best interest of public safety to regulate parking in the area near the town's recreation park;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners that parking shall not be allowed at the recreation park, along the north and south sides of Crescent Street, from the intersection with Davis Mill Road eastward to the intersection with Legion Lane, and that signage shall be erected in the specified areas that designate NO PARKING AT ANY TIME.

FIFTY DOLLAR CIVIL PENALTY. Violations of this Ordinance shall subject the offender to a civil penalty of \$50.00 if such penalty is paid within thirty (30) days of the violation, and a civil penalty of \$75.00 plus cost of court, if any, if the \$50.00 civil penalty is not paid within thirty (30) days after the violation.

TOWING. In addition to any penalty assessed herein, a owner or operator of a vehicle parked in violation of this Ordinance, which has previously been cited for violation of this Ordinance, may be towed away and stored by independent towing contractors hired by the Town, with all costs, including storage fees, being the responsibility of the owner or operator of the vehicle.

APPEALS. A person owning or operating a vehicle which has received a parking violation as described herein, may appeal the issuance of that violation. Appeal must be made in writing and filed with the Town Clerk within ten (10) days of the issuance of the violation. The person designated by the Town shall review evidence submitted by the appellant and issue a determination.
